What your typed proposal should contain:

I. Cover Sheet (use form on page 2)

II. Overview and Academic Rationale for the Proposed Individualized Major

Briefly explain why existing major programs within the College do not adequately meet your educational, professional, or personal goals. Provide a *general* explanation of the nature of the program you and your faculty advisors have developed. In addition, please briefly comment on how your program meets the expectations of the College's Mission (<u>https://about.providence.edu/mission/</u>). Also, *briefly* explain the rationale for the *specific title* of your proposed Individualized Major. Approved Individualized Major titles will be reflected on the official academic record (2-3 page maximum).

III. Proposed Course of Study

List the courses and other experiences (e.g., internships) which will comprise your program. Most majors have Major *requirements* and Major *elective* courses, with ten or eleven courses from these lists contributing to the Major GPA. List Major Requirements and Major Electives separately. Indicate on these lists which courses you have already completed (by showing the grade you received next to each completed course). Please ensure that approximately 2/3 of your program's required courses are "upper-level" (i.e., beyond introductory level—normally, 300-400 level) courses. *Briefly justify* the selection of the courses in this list. How do the courses fit into the rationale you provided in Part II for your overall program goals?

IV. Calendar

Make a list of the courses you've taken or plan to take each semester up to your projected graduation date, and indicate on this calendar which courses fulfill your Major (M) and Core (C) requirements. Make sure you've listed *each* of the College's Core Requirements. If you plan to take *specific* Core courses in order to fulfill your Individualized Major goals, make sure to indicate that on the form. This calendar establishes your plan to complete your program; it shows you and your advisors where the critical timing issues may be, and it demonstrates that you can in fact graduate according to your plans.

V. Required Documentation

(A) Attach an unofficial copy of your Providence College transcript, as well as transcripts of credit received from other colleges or universities. If you do not have copies of transcripts from other colleges, see the Registrar's Office, Harkins 310.

(B) The Proposal Cover Sheet, signed by the faculty sponsors who have agreed to act as the advisory committee for your program.

(C) The "Department Chair Acknowledgment of Individualized Studies Major Proposal" forms for each department represented in your proposal.

Include these along with the 2-3 page overview and the three forms listing your coursework.



ONCE APPROVED, <u>ANY</u> CHANGE TO THE INDIVIDUALIZED MAJOR REQUIREMENTS WILL BE ALLOWED ONLY WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE DEAN OF UNDERGRADUATE & GRADUATE STUDIES FOLLOWING THE SUBMISSION OF A STUDENT PETITION FOR A SPECIFIC CHANGE (INCLUDING A BRIEF RATIONALE FOR THE CHANGE). THE PETITION MUST INCLUDE THE WRITTEN SUPPORT OF EACH OF THE STUDENT'S MAJOR ADVISORS FOR THE PROPOSED CHANGE.
